Welcome INN (Interfaith Needs Network)

Meals are served daily from 4:15 p.m. to the community's homeless and hungry. Volunteers from St. Edward help with set up, serve and clean up tasks for Friday night meals at Doheny State Beach, near the public showers station. In addition, some St. Edward parishioners provide hot meals several times per month.

Another quick, but important volunteer task in which St. Edward volunteers are involved is pick-up and delivery of extra lunch food, donated by St. Margaret's Episcopal School in San Juan Capistrano. Volunteers pick up the lunches on Fridays at 1:15 p.m. during the school year, then deliver the food to the Welcome INN dinner site.
