

Wedding Photography and Videography Guidelines St. Edward the Confessor Catholic Church and San Felipe de Jesús Chapel

Flash photography and video spotlights are not permitted within the Church.

During the ceremony, the photographer and videographer are not allowed in the center aisle, the sanctuary (where the altar is), and the area between the sanctuary and the front pews.

The videographer must remain stationary during the ceremony and may stand either in the balcony (in the church) or the far right or left sides of the church/chapel.

The photographer may utilize the side aisles, the rear of the church behind the pews, and the balcony (in the church).

Photography/videography equipment may not be stored within the sanctuary.

Posed photos may not be taken inside the church. Posed photos may be taken before and after the wedding anywhere on the premises outside of the church.

No drones are permitted for ceremonies at either location

Note for the bride and groom — If you are providing a wedding program for your guests, we suggest you include the following: "We request that our guests respect the sacredness of the church and the wedding ceremony by turning off their cell phones and refraining from using flash photography."
